**BECOME AN ELECTION JUDGE**

Judges of election are responsible for the administration of election procedures in the polling place on Election Day. They are in the position of ensuring the election process is administered fairly and in accordance with election laws.

**What are the qualifications to be a judge of election?**

- Be a citizen of the United States;
- Be of good repute and character;
- Be able to speak, read and write the English language;
- Be skilled in the four fundamental rules of mathematics;
- Be of good understanding and capable;
- Be a resident of and be registered to vote in Winnebago County; and
- Be responsible for your transportation to and from the polling place you have been scheduled to work.
